We walk to the kitchen.

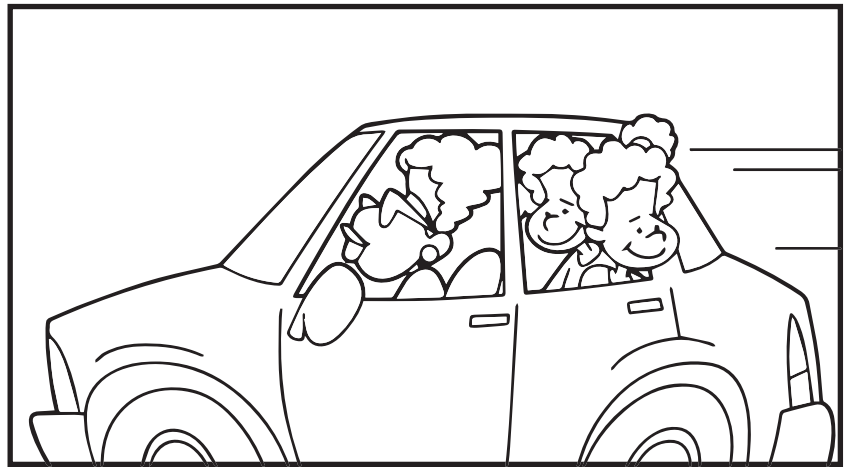
We hungrily eat our breakfast.
