- The Grade 7 T-shirts will be worn with their school uniform but more information regarding Grade 7 T-shirts will be communicated soon.

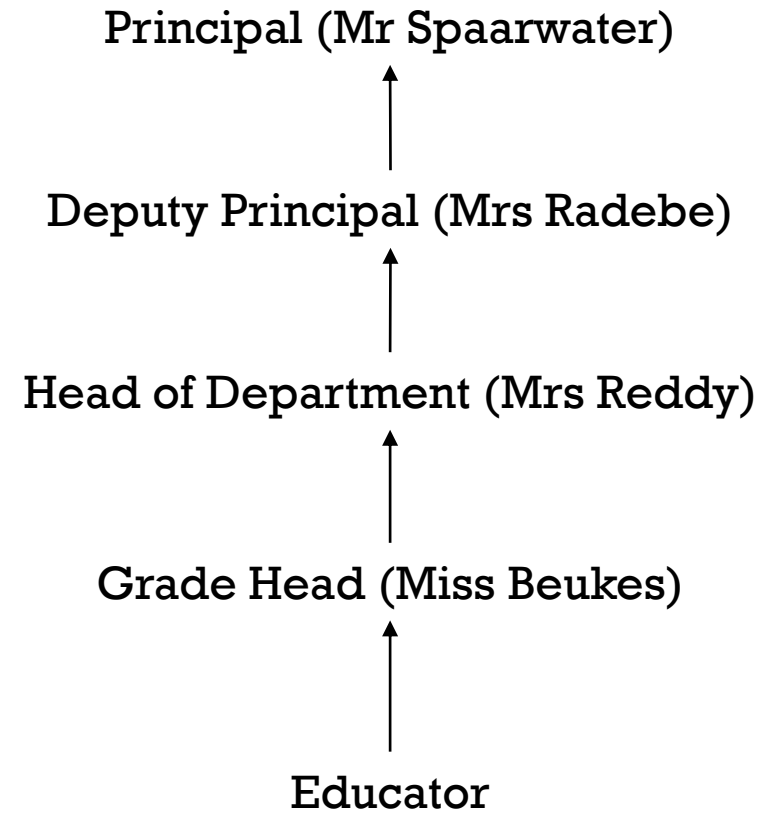


Communication between teachers and parents

Line of communication



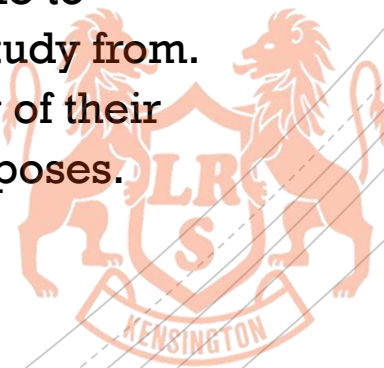
What is expected of you as the learner for 2021

- **Mathematics:** Mental maths will be done in register period to help nourish the mind and it will benefit in the classroom when the subject is being taught. Homework given for Mathematics is compulsory and needs to be done in order to complete this years curriculum. Classwork books will go home on a daily basis but Assessment books will remain at school unless parents need to sign assessments.
- **Afrikaans:** Learners will get work for the days they are not at school and needs to be completed on a daily basis. Work that is not completed in class needs to be completed at home on a daily basis to stay up to date.
- **English, SS, EMS, NS, Technology, LO and CA:** Work will be done in class and if work is not completed in class please make sure it is done at home to stay up to date.



Procedures for homework and work to be completed on the learners off days.

- Please make sure all work is up to date. This is a busy year and it is very important that the learners are up to date with their work.
- Please check homework diaries on a regular basis in case there may be a message from an educator or homework notices.
- All the work that your child does at home and in class will be marked and checked in class. There will be Mathematics, Afrikaans and English work to be completed on a regular basis.
- As mentioned already, any work that is not completed in class needs to be done at home.
- NO textbooks will be allocated to any learner due to COVID-19, learners will receive worksheets to study from. Please encourage your child to not misplace any of their worksheets as they will need them for study purposes.



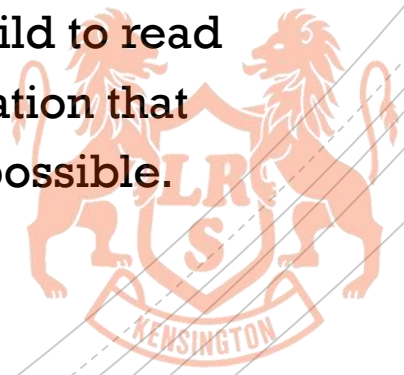
Valedictory service and Grade 7 Farewell
