Monday 13 April	<p><b>Phonics book:</b> Week 11, ll words for Monday. Write sentences with bell and tell. Remember your Capital letter, full stop and words to make your sentence exciting. Practise your handwriting. Remember your rules (always work from top to bottom, left to right and start at 2 o'clock and go anti clockwise for circle letters.). Practice Cc and remember to use head, tummy, tail.</p> <p><b>Adjectives:</b> Are words that describe a person or thing (a noun). They make your sentence more exciting and people want to read more when you make your sentence exciting. Try to use these words in your sentences. E.g.: The loud bell woke all the sleeping children. Draw a picture on how to stay safe at home.</p> <p><b>Read:</b> Practise you sight words, grade 2 term 1. Try to make sentences with your sight words (Just read them, do not write them).</p>
Tuesday 14 April	<p><b>Phonics book:</b> Week 11, ll words for Tuesday. Write sentences with well and fell. Remember your Capital letter, full stop and words to make your sentence exciting. Remember to use a capital letter, full stop and adjectives. You can also use a question mark or exclamation mark. (exclamation mark is used when something is said and doesn't need an answer, it is not a question but a statement.). Write five exciting sentences to explain the picture you drew yesterday about keeping safe at home.</p> <p><b>Read:</b> Practise you sight words, grade 2 term 1. Try to make sentences with your sight words (Just read them, do not write them).</p>
Wednesday 15 April	<p><b>Phonics book:</b> Week 11, ll words for Wednesday. Write sentences with kill and will. Remember your Capital letter, full stop and words to make your sentence exciting. Remember to use a capital letter, full stop and adjectives. Practise writing Kk, remember head, tummy, tails. Write a sentence using as many k words as you can think of.</p> <p><b>Read:</b> Practise you sight words, grade 2 term 1.
